Glass Worlds: Paperweights from the ROM's Collection

If you have not already seen this exhibit and the new expansion of the Michael Lee-Chin Crystal space at the ROM, you should make plans to go. The Glass Worlds exhibit features over 250 paperweights, both antique and contemporary. In the exhibit area is an excellent short video on paperweight and cane making. The ROM has acquired paperweights from our own member artists which are also displayed.

The Glass Worlds exhibit runs until November 25, 2007 in the Samuel European Galleries' exhibition space. The Royal Ontario Museum is open Saturdays-Thursdays (10:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m.) and on Fridays (10:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m.).

The ROM has published a companion book to the exhibit written by Brian Musselwhite, Assistant Curator. It features photographs and descriptions of the pieces displayed. It is available for purchase at the ROM for \$14.99, through the University of Toronto Press, or from Chapters bookstores www.chapters.indigo.ca.

Wheaton Arts Paperweight Fest, May 14-17, 2008

Wheaton Arts and Cultural Center (the Village's new name) is already planning next year's paperweight fest. The Delaware Valley PCA will again be collaborating with Wheaton in coordinating the event. Plans are being made for international speakers, demonstrations, raffle and much more for attendees to enjoy and learn.

In 2006, volunteers from the Delaware Valley PCA assembled shadow boxes made from donated lampworked pieces and millefiori canes. Altogether there were seven boxes donated, the largest of which was 20 inches square and the six smaller frames were 8" x 10". The names of the contributing artists were spelled out with letter canes in each assembly. The shadow box with John Deacons canes is shown below.

They are avid collectors of "J" Glass weights and have about 85 in their collection. Their aim is to catalogue the "J" Glass period of John Deacons with the hope of publishing their results in the Cambridge Club Newsletter and PCA Bulletin. John Deacons ran the "J" Glass studio in Scotland from 1978 to 1983. A large number of "J" Glass weights were editions made solely for the U.S. market.

Debbie Tarsitano Retrospective Exhibition
